### VISA Issues

Dear Participants, please read the following rules and regulations regarding Malta's Visa regime:

- 1) holders of a valid passport issued by Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, and The Netherlands do not need a visa to visit Malta as long as their stay does not exceed 90 days;
- 2) holders of a valid **biometric** passport issued by Macedonia, Montenegro and Serbia do not need a visa to visit Malta as long as their stay does not exceed 90 days;
- 3) holders of a valid passport issued by Russia, Ukraine and Armenia should contact the Maltese Embassy in Russia either by e-mail at [maltaembassy.moscow@gov.mt](mailto:maltaembassy.moscow@gov.mt) or by phone on 007 495 6624220;

- 5) holders of a valid Georgian passport should contact the Italian Embassy in Tbilisi either by e-mail at [embassy.tbilisi@esteri.it](mailto:embassy.tbilisi@esteri.it) or by phone on 0099532 996418;
- 6) holders of a valid passport issued by Kazakhstan should contact the Italian Embassy in Astana either by e-mail at [ambasciata.astana@esteri.it](mailto:ambasciata.astana@esteri.it) or by phone on 007 3172 910307 or 007 3172 910315;
- 7) holders of a valid Bosnian passport should contact the Austrian Embassy in Sarajevo either by e-mail at [sarajewo-ob@bmeia.gv.at](mailto:sarajewo-ob@bmeia.gv.at) or by phone on 00387 33279400;
